


1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation. Note: This product may be mounted stand-alone or in conjunction with Winch Tray P/N 46-23685 (sold separately).


STEP 1: Removal and Trimming


- Remove Grille and Filler Panel. (Figures 2-7)
- Vehicles without factory tow hooks: Locate on the bumper the cover insert. This cover will need to be trimmed to install the bottom bracket. (Figure 1)
- Vehicles with factory tow hooks: Tow hooks will need to be removed, review figures 8-11 to remove the bumper in order to access the tow hook bolts.





















Remove all of upper the screws holding the grille to the upper radiator support and carefully pull it from the vehicle. Note: there are several inaccessible clips that provide some retention on the grille. They will pop loose when you pull on the grille.















- Re-install the bumper if the bumper was previously removed. Do not re-install bolt that is circled on Figure 9
- Locate the Passenger and Driver Side Bottom Brackets (items 4 & 5 on Figure 12), and position each one in the tow hook pockets (Figure 13).










Loosely attach each of the Bottom Brackets by using (2) M12 Hex Head Flange Bolts (item 6), (1) M12 Stud plate (item 14) and (3) M12 Serrated Flange Nuts (item 7). (Figure 14)


Step 3: Installing Upper Brackets


- Remove the upper factory bumper bolt that is circled on figure 9. If it was not previously removed.
- Locate the Upper Support Straps (items 2 & 3 on Figure 15) and loosely attach them to where the upper factory bumper bolts where removed on the previous step.
- Measure and adjust the Upper Support Straps (Figure 17); then torque down the factory M10 bolts to 35 ft-lbs.
- Re-install the filler panel and the factory grille.












STEP 4: Installing the Push Bumper without Winch Tray


- Locate and attach the Push Bumper (Figure 18) to the Bottom Brackets using (6) M12 Hex Socket Button Head Screws (item 11), (4) M12 Cupped Washers (item 12) and (4) M12 Serrated Flange Nuts (item 13). (Figure 19)
- Attach the Push Bumper to the Upper Support Straps using (2) M10 Hex Socket Button Head Screws (item 9), (2) M10 Cupped Washers (item 10) and (2) M10 Serrated Flange Nuts (item 8). (Figure 19)
- Align and adjust the Push Bumper then tighten and torque all M10 hardware to 30-35 ft-lbs. and all M12 to 50-55 ft-lbs.

STEP 5: Installing Push Bumper With Winch Tray (46-23685)

- Loosely install the Winch Tray per the Winch Tray Install sheet.
- If installing the Winch Tray you will use the Spacer (Item 15) that is included in this kit. (Figure 20)
- Place the spacer between the Push Bumper and the Bottom Bracket as shown on Figure 21. Note: The Bottom Bracket is supplied with the Winch Tray (46-23685).
- Align the holes from the Push Bumper and the Spacer with the Slot on the Bottom Bracket.
- Then secure the Spacer and Push Bumper by using (1) M12 Serrated Flange Nut (item 13), (1) M12 Cupped Washer (item 12) and (1) M12 Hex Socket Button Head Screw, per side. Note: refer to Winch Tray installation instructions (46-23685) for torque specs and hardware on securing the Winch Tray to the Push Bumper.









CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- REGULAR WAXING IS RECOMMENDED. DO NOT USE ANY TYPE OF POLISH OR WAX THAT MAY CONTAIN ABRASIVES.
- STAINLESS STEEL PRODUCTS CAN BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER. STAINLESS STEEL POLISH SHOULD BE USED TO POLISH SMALL SCRATCHES.
- GLOSS BLACK FINISHES SHOULD BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER.
