
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





PROCEDURE


- Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage.
 Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Find the release two seat cable wires on both the rear driver and passenger side of the vehicle and flip the rear seats toward the front to allow room for easy access. See **Figure 1 & 2** for reference.







- 3. Remove both the driver seatbelt pillar molding shown in **Figure 3**.
- 4. Remove the T45 torx head bolt securing the seatbelt to the vehicle pillar. Locate and install the Driver Mounting Bracket (Item 5) at this same location under the seatbelt mount using the a M12 Flat washer (31) and the OEM torx head bolt. Make sure to align the Bracket's tab into the frame slot. Tighten it completely at this time and torque to 35 to 40 ft-lbs. See **Figure 4 & 5** for reference.
- 5. Using a 5/16" drill bit increases the hole size on both pillars as shown on image below. **Figure 6.**
- 6. Using the provided M6 Fish wire, carefully, through the square holes place the provided M6 bolt plates (26) into the 5/6" holes. Use the provided poly retainer (27) to hold the bolt plate in place (red arrow). Figures 7 & 8.
- 7. Using M6 flange nuts install the driver and passenger top straps (29, 30) (Bigger strap is passenger) to the pillars. Strap flange must be parallel to the square holes (see image below, red markings). Do not install the frame yet. Tighten nuts and proceed to step 5 on install sheets. Note: Might need to do small trim the pillar molding to clear the strap. **Figure 9.**
- 8. Reinstall the seatbelt pillar molding.
- 9. Repeat for passenger side (Item 6).











Using the provided Driver and Passenger Cutting Templates (Items 22 & 23), cut into the seatbelt pillar molding shown in order to create an opening for the Driver and Passenger Mounting Brackets (Items 5 & 6).

Cutting Instructions using the provided Cutting Templates (Items 22 & 23)

- Align the template properly and it can be easiest to start by drilling a small pilot hole. See **Figure** 7 for reference.
- Using this pilot hole as a reference once it appears to be aligned with the mounting bracket hole, you can use the cutting tool to make the 2 inch diameter hole opening for the mounting bracket. See Figure 12 & 13 for reference.
- The seatbelt pillar molding may also be removed to drill completely through once you are confident of the hole location.
- On the PASSENGER side, be VERY careful when drilling and cutting because of the AC air dam shown in Figure 10.






8. Locate and loosely install the Driver and Passenger Side Extension Mounting Bracket (Items 9 & 10) using the provided M10 hardware (Item 20) as shown in Figure 14.






- 9. Follow the seatbelt down to its floor mounting location and remove the OEM bolt. See **Figure 15** for reference.
- 10. Locate and install the Driver and Passenger Floor Straps (Items 7 & 8) <u>loosely</u> using the OEM bolt with room for adjustment as shown in **Figure 16.**








- 11. Locate and loosely align the Cross Frame (Item 12) to the Driver and Passenger Side Extension Mounting Brackets (Items 9 & 10) as shown in **Figure 17 & 18.**
- 12. With the Driver and Passenger Floor Straps installed and the Cross Member mounted, locate and loosely install the Center Filer Panel (Item 2) to the floor straps loosely with room for adjustment using the provided M6 hardware (Items 13 & 14) and M8 hardware (Items 15, 18, & 19). See **Figure 19, 20, & 21** for reference.
- 13. While installing the Center Filer Panel, also install the Belt Support Bracket (Item 11) loosely with room for adjustment with the provided M8 hardware (Items 15, 18, & 19). See **Figure 21 & 22** for reference.


















- 14. If you are installing the optional Prisoner Seat (35-14075), do so at this time. The prisoner seat will mount in between the Cross Frame and Upper Screen. See **Figure 26** for reference.
- 15. Locate and loosely install the Screen (Item 1) using the supplied M8 hardware (Items 16 (long bolt), & 17-19). See **Figure 26** for reference.

- 16. Locate and install the Driver and Passenger Side Filer Panels (Items 3 & 4) using the provided #8 Self Tapping Sheet Metal Screws (Item 21). *Note:* Make sure to align the Filer Panel slot with the Floor Strap when installing them. See **Figures** 23, 24, & 25 for reference.
- 17. Install Cover Plate (24) Using M8 hardware 15, 18, & 19.




17. Adjust and align as needed. Torque hardware as specified: M6 to 8-11 ft. lbs., M8 to 15-18 ft. lbs., M10 to 35-38 ft. lbs.
