
PROCEDURE

- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 - Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Remove the rear plastic corner panels to uncover the rear seat belts mount locations. **Figure 1**.
- 3. Loosen and remove the bolt holding the seat belt and save bolt spacer and washer for reinstallation. Don't remove the hardware from the seat belt. **Figure 1**.
- 4. Install side bracket as shown in **Figure 1 & 2**. Be sure to clear the electronic parts, seat belt bracket will sit at an angle, and align the bracket evenly with the rear window. Bracket should not touch the window. **Figures 1 & 2**.
- 5. Install bottom bracket on car seat anchor using Backing bolt plate (Item 6) ,M6 hardware (Items 8-10 &13), and U-clip (Item 7). See **Figure 3.**
- 6. Install each bumper (Item 5) in the rear window guard (Item 1) optionally using two large M5 washers (Item 7) as spacers (washer spacers are used to add length to create contact between the bumper and the glass window. Use as needed) and one M6 Acorn nut (Item 11) as shown in **Figure 4 &5**.






- 7. Install the window guard as shown in Figure 5. Use hardware per Figure 5.
- 8. Adjust window where needed.
- 9. Before installing trim, trim as needed in order to clear bracket. See Figure 6.
- 10. WARNING: AVOID METAL PARTS TOUCHING THE WINDOW GLASS. NOT DOING THIS MAY CRACK WINDOW.
- 11. Tighten and torque hardware to: M6 7-9 ft-lbs.
- 12. Carefully place back the rear plastic corner panels.





CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- REGULAR WAXING IS RECOMMENDED. DO NOT USE ANY TYPE OF POLISH OR WAX THAT MAY CONTAIN ABRASIVES.
- STAINLESS STEEL PRODUCTS CAN BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER. STAINLESS STEEL POLISH SHOULD BE USED TO POLISH SMALL SCRATCHES.
- GLOSS BLACK FINISHES SHOULD BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER.
