




PROCEDURE

- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 - Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- Remove the OEM front bumper by removing the inner 3 factory nuts on each side securing the bumper. Disconnect any wiring connectors pertaining to the front bumper and remove the bumper carefully. See Figures 1 for reference.





- Starting on the frame just behind the bumper, loosen the two factory bolts at the locations shown in Figure 2 & 3. Note: Loosen the bolts enough to allow room for mounting the Driver and Passenger Mounting Brackets in Step 2.
- Install the Mounting Brackets (Items 3 & 4) to the two factory bolts as shown in Figure 2 & 3. Tighten the bolts to secure the mounting brackets.
- Reinstall the OEM front bumper at this time.







- 6. Use the supplied Template (Items 4 & 5) to determine where to drill a 1-1/2" hole in the vehicle's bumper. Follow the instructions on the template, then mark and drill the 1-1/2" hole needed to install the Pit Bar Assembly (Item 1). See Figure 4 for template placement.
- 7. Install the Spacers (Item 6) to the Mounting Brackets using the provided M12 Serrated Screw (Item 13). See Figure 6.
- 8. Loosely install the Pit Bar Assembly (1) to your Push Bumper (P# 36-54085) using the supplied M10 Hardware. See **Figure 5.** *Note: Push Bumper (P# 36-54085) sold separately,*






9. Use the supplied M12 Hardware and Spacer (Item 6) to secure the Pit Bar (1) to the Mounting Bracket on either side (Items 2 & 3). See **Figures 6 & 7** for reference.





- 10. Align and adjust the Push Bumper and Pit Bar as needed then torque all hardware as follows: M10 Hardware to 35 ft-lb, M12 Hardware to 60 ft-lb.
- 11. Optional Step: the provided holes on the Pit Bar can be used to mount an emergency light. See Figures 8 & 9 for refer-




