

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
PROCEDURE

- Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage.
 Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Remove the entire front grille and fascia from the front of the vehicle. There are a number of plastic fasteners and metal screws holding it on. Carefully remove the clips and screws so that there is no damage done to the fascia.
- 3. Open the hood and remove the nine plastic rivets and the two screws with the plastic hood release handle. Remove the top plastic cover, then remove the screws holding the grille. See **Figures 1 & 2** for reference.
- 4. Remove the screws located under the fenders that hold the front fascia. Carefully pull the fender trim. Remove all the screws under the vehicle to loosen the bottom part of the fascia. See **Figures 3 through 5** for reference.
- 5. Remove the screws under each side of the See **Figures 6 & 7** for reference.







- 6. With help, disconnect any wiring connections from the fascia and carefully remove the whole front fascia.
- 7. Remove the plastic cover on top of the internal bumper and radiator support, and discard it.
- 8. If equipped with tow hooks remove them and save them. The hardware will be reused with the mounting bracket installation in the following step.
- 9. Install the Driver and Passenger Lower Brackets (Items 6-7) to the chassis using the Clamp Brackets (Items 10-11) and provided M10 & M12 hardware (Items 12-18). Reuse the factory bolt with the outer clamp bracket. Leave them loose for now. See **Figure 8 & 9** for reference. *Note:* Chassis mount holes are not mirrored to each other. Please refer to **Figures 8** & **9**.
- 10. Tighten and torque M10 to 35-40 ft-lbs. and M12 hardware to 50-55 ft-lbs.




12. Before installing the front fascia, trim the lower grille slots as shown in Figures 10 & 11. Then, reinstall the front fascia.






- 13. Once the front fascia is reinstalled, install the Extension Brackets (Items 8-9) using the supplied M12 hardware (Items 22-24). See **Figure 12** for reference.
- 14. Using the provided templates (Item 28), cut at the dotted lines and place the indicated side 2" from the center of the fascia and the top edge of the bumper, close to the edge of the grill, carefully drill a 2" hole at each side of the fascia and carefully clean the hole edges. See **Figure 13** for reference.
- 15. Remove the factory bolt shown in **Figure 14** and save it to be used in the next step.




- 16. Place the upper brackets into the previously drilled holes and install them loosely using the previously removed bolts. See **Figure 14** for reference.
- 17. Install the grille guard to the bottom brackets (**Figure 12**) using M12 button head bolts M12 Bellville washers and M12 serrated flange nuts. Slightly tighten hardware for now to secure the grille guard.
- 18. Secure the grill guard at the upper area using M10 button head bolts M10 Bellville washers and M10 serrated flange nuts.
- 20. Adjust as needed and torque all hardware as specified: M10 to 35-40 ft-lbs., M12 to 50-55 ft-lbs.

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- 21. Locate and install the Driver and Passenger Wings (Items 2-3) using the supplied M8 hardware (Items 25-27). See **Figure 15** for reference.
- 22. Align and adjust the Driver and Passenger Wings as needed. Fully tighten and torque all M8 hardware to 15-18 ft-lbs.


