



### **PROCEDURE**

- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
  - Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Remove all electrical connections.
- 3. Remove the two lower bolts at the bottom of the bumper. See Figure 1
- 4. Remove the six bolts holding the rear bumper on.
- 5. Remove the rear bumper.



6. Mount the support brackets (Item 6) on the mounting brackets as seen in **Figure 2** using the OE hardware.




5. **If sensors are equipped:** Install parking sensors by inserting into the holes on bumper and pressing with sensor L-tabs against bumper plate. Fasten L-tabs with the supplied M6 hardware (10-13). **See Figure 2-5**. Use supplied double sided tape between sensor and L-Tab to keep the sensor from rotating.

If sensors are not equipped: Place the supplied plugs in the sensor holes.

6. Use zip ties to secure sensor in place.


*Note*: Be sure to maintain the orientation of the sensor so that it remains consistent with its original orientation.

7. Tighten M6 hardware to 5-7 ft-lbs.






Make sure to maintain OEM orientation of sensors



- 8. Using the supplied M12 hardware, loosely assemble the mounting brackets to the factory tow hitch. See Figure 6.
- 9. Loosely assemble the bumper on to the mounting brackets using the supplied M12 hardware.




- 11. Install the trailer plug in to the trailer plug slot in the bumper.
- 12. Install the license plate at this time.

#### WARNING.


After you have mounted bumper on main brackets. CAREFULLY open tailgate. While tailgate is open, adjust the height of the bumper so that it has about 3/8" of clearance with respect to the tailgate. Then, tighten all M12 hardware to 50-55 ft-lbs.

### License plate lights installation.


- 1. Disconnect the battery from your vehicle.
- 2. Locate the license plate lights (pre-installed) in the bumper. Pop out the lights by squeezing the clips in on the backside. **See Figure 7**
- 3. Locate the factory wiring for the license plate lights. Strip back the wiring on the factory harness and supplied light. Using connectors, crimp the red wire on the positive factory wire and the black wire to the factory ground wire. **See Figure 8** Note: Only the portion shown on **Figure 9** will be needed from the connector.








4. Push the light back in until it clips into place. Repeat on the opposite side. See Figure 10



- 5. If you are installing the optional reverse lights, remove the mesh covers and install the optional lights with the M6 hardware. **See Figure 11**
- 6. Locate the factory wiring for the reverse lights. Strip back the wiring on the factory harness and supplied light. Using connectors, crimp the red wire on the positive factory wire and the black wire to the factory ground wire.
- 7. Reconnect your battery.


